PDC changes Canadian qualification process for Ladbrokes.com World Championship

Mr. Tim Darby, Chief Executive of the Professional Darts Corporation (PDC) has confirmed that two Canadians will once again qualify to compete at the Ladbrokes.com World Championship but that the PDC has changed their method of selection.

Previously, two Canadian representatives qualified for the world championship based on their standings in the Men's Singles event at the NDFC National Championship. Although many understood this to be awarded by the NDFC, this was not the case. The National Championship was simply the event selected by the PDC for use in determining the top two Canadians.

Five PDC events are scheduled in North America in 2007. From these events, the PDC is running an Order of Merit based on prize money won. The top two players from the USA and the top two Canadians will earn qualification into the Ladbrokes.com World Championship. If they have already qualified, then the third placed player will earn the place. These 5 PDC events are:

- PDC US Open – May 18 to 20, 2007, Uncasville, CT
- Las Vegas Players Championship – July 1, 2007, Las Vegas NV
- Las Vegas Desert Classic – July 2 to 8, 2007, Las Vegas NV
- Peachtree Open – August 24 to 26, 2007, Atlanta GA
- Windy City Open – September 13 to 16, 2007, Chicago IL
