Another record year for the Member League Championship

The Member League Championship Program achieved another record-breaking season with 24 teams competing in their league playoffs, for a total of 116 participants. This is an astounding 60% increase over the previous year. A total of 7 teams competed at the Member League Provincial Championships held on Saturday, March 10, 2007. Although 9 teams were eligible, 2 teams were unable to attend.

This program was launched in 2004 with the objective of providing a fun, yet competitive competition which fosters team spirit and camaraderie and to encourage more grassroots and league members to participate in Darts Alberta programs.

As I walked into the venue at the Member League Provincial Championship this year, I realized how successfully the program has become – I didn't recognize the majority of the competitors in the venue.

The Provincial Championship Team earns a trip to the 2007 Canadian Open, a Darts Alberta jacket and gold medal. The second place team earns a Darts Alberta shirt and silver medal; and the third place team earns a bronze medal.
