Youth participation at the 2007 AGM Shoot exceeds expectations

A record-breaking number of participants attended the 2007 Annual General Meeting and AGM Shoot on Sunday, March 11, 2007 in Calgary.

In order to provide more competitive opportunities for Darts Alberta's youth athletes, a youth competition was held in conjunction with the Men's and Women's Singles Ranked Tournament. There were 96 members were in attendance for the Annual General Meeting and a total of 90 competed in the AGM Shoot events in the following disciplines:

- Men's Singles – 43 entries
- Women's Singles – 27 entries
- Youth Singles – 20 entries

Highlights of the AGM include:

- Reports were provided by each of the Executive members, providing updates of the various programs offered by Darts Alberta.
- The 2005-06 Financial Statements were presented and adopted.
- There were no changes to the Darts Alberta Executive, as a result of the elections.
- A special resolution was adopted to amend the Darts Alberta Bylaws.
- Feedback was provided by the membership regarding changes to the Member League Championship Program.
