Alberta youth team wins gold at the 2007 youth nationals

There was history in the making at the 2007 Youth Nationals held on the May long weekend in Montreal Quebec. Team Alberta and Team Saskatchewan tied in first place with 84 points each to both take home the Canada Cup Gold Medal; an astounding 14 points ahead of the Bronze Medal team from Quebec (70 points). The Canada Cup is the most prestigious team award available at the National Championships; consisting of the Grand Aggregate of points earned by all competitors in the Singles and Doubles events – the ultimate team effort! Ontario has held the Canada Cup title since 1992; and since the Canada Cup was introduced in 1986, this is only the fourth time that another province, other than Ontario, has held the title.

The 2007 Alberta Youth Team took home an amazing total of 10 medals, including 3 Gold, 2 Silver and 5 Bronze. The other 2 gold medals were achieved by Chris Moss (Calgary) in the Junior Male Singles event; and Vanessa Janes & Kliman Snow (both from Calgary) in the Senior Mixed Doubles event.

Special congratulations are extended to the entire 2007 Youth Alberta Team on their outstanding performance and to all of the individual medal winners in their respective events!

The hard work and dedication of our youth competitors, the increased competitive opportunities in Alberta for our youth members and the new coaching development opportunities for our Alberta coaches are all believed to have played a significant role in the success of the 2007 Alberta Youth Team.
