## **Intermediate development awards drawn at the 2007 Rodeo City Open**

Darts Alberta extends our congratulations to **Bill McDowall** and **Georgina Gibb** on being awarded the 2007 Intermediate Development Award. Bill and Georgina will each receive a \$250.00 credit toward attending any Darts Alberta Ranked Tournament during the 2007-08 Ranked Tournament season. As a direct result of grant funding through the Alberta Sports Recreation Parks and Wildlife Foundation, Alberta was able to create a number of new programs for our members, including the Elite Development and the Intermediate Development Awards.

While the Elite Development Award is based solely on an individual's achievements, the objective of the Intermediate Development Award is to encourage all members to participate in Darts Alberta ranked tournaments by offering an award based on participation, regardless of individual results achieved.

Each time a member participates in a Darts Alberta Ranked Singles Event, they receive a participation point regardless of their final standings in that event. At the end of the ranking season (April 30<sup>th</sup>), all members receive an entry into a draw, with the exception of the top 2 ranked men and top two ranked women that have received the Elite Development Award. The numbers of entries is a direct result of the number of participation points received. If a member has 6 participation points, their name is entry in the draw 6 times.

From all of the entries, one male and one female recipient are randomly drawn to receive the Intermediate Development Award prize package. This year's draw was held during the 2007 Rodeo City Open.
