New Darts Alberta Bylaws take effect July 9, 2007

A project that has lasted well over 3 years has finally come to completion. The new Darts Alberta Bylaws were approved by and filed with Alberta Corporate Registry as of July 9, 2007.

Although many changes to the Bylaws were made throughout the years, society bylaws only come into effect when approved by Alberta Corporate Registries. Unfortunately, none of those previous revisions were ever filed. As a result, Darts Alberta was operating under the original set of bylaws approved in 1985. The original new bylaws were approved by the membership at the 2004 Annual General Meeting and submitted for approval. Due to numerous articles requiring changes, further changes were brought forward at subsequent Annual General Meetings. The bylaws were submitted to Corporate Registry with the changes approved at the 2007 Annual General Meeting and only two additional minor revisions were required.

- Any reference pertaining to Darts Alberta Constitution was required to be changed to read Darts Alberta *Bylaws*.
- Clarification was required in reference to how members vote. Based on current practice, the following two articles were included to meet Corporate Registries requirements:

9.11 *Members shall only be permitted to vote in person at any general or special meeting.*

9.11 *Voting by proxy shall not be permitted.*

With the above revisions made, the new bylaws were finally approved and are now in effect. A copy of the new 2007 Bylaws can be found at:
