Darts Alberta approved for new Association Support Grant

Darts Alberta was successful in its application to Alberta Sport, Parks, Recreation and Wildlife Foundation for a new Association Support Grant. This new grant initiative was developed by the Government of Alberta to provide the funds necessary to hire full time administrative resources for volunteer organizations with limited or no staffing resources. This approved funding is over and above the current annual sport funding received.

At the December 2007 Darts Alberta Executive Meeting, a thorough review was conducted of the duties currently performed within each volunteer position. Administrative functions were separated from those duties that will remain as part of each volunteer position and will serve as part of a new Administrative contract.

Darts Alberta is pleased to announce that this annual contract has been awarded to SKORR Services. As a result, Sandi Orr (owner of SKORR Services) has resigned her position as the Darts Alberta Secretary, effective immediately. With the majority of the duties currently performed by the Secretary being deemed administrative in nature a seamless transition is anticipated.

Darts Alberta is also pleased to announce that Dean Lawson of Medicine Hat has accepted the appointment as the new Secretary for the remainder of the term ending June 30, 2008 and the upcoming elections held at the 2008 Annual General Meeting.

At the request of the Darts Alberta Executive, Sandi Orr will remain in the position of Provincial Director for the remainder of her current term appointment ending June 30, 2008 but has relinquished all voting rights on the Darts Alberta Executive Committee to remove any perception of a conflict of interest.
