Darts Alberta continues to use PDC Desert Classic for Elite Development Award

Darts Alberta is pleased to announce that the Elite Athlete Development Initiative will continue in 2007, with the PDC-Ranked Desert Classic as the primary event. The Desert Classic will be held in Las Vegas from July 2 to 8, 2007.

The objective of this initiative is to encourage competitive spirit and increased participation at Darts Alberta Ranked Tournaments, as well as enhance athletic performance at the Elite Level. The Darts Alberta ranking list is in effect September 1 to August 31 each year. The top 2 ranked men and the top 2 ranked women as of April 30, 2007 will each be awarded with the following:

\$1,000.00 toward travel, accommodation and entry fee expenses
associated with traveling to the 2007 PDC Desert Classic in Las Vegas.

Award recipients are responsible for making their own arrangements for transportation, accommodations and submitting tournament entry forms and fees, and are required to sign a Funding Agreement setting out the terms and conditions of the funding.

If a recipient is unable to attend the 2007 Desert Classic in Las Vegas, he/she can make a request to Darts Alberta to attend the PDC Le Skratch (May 11-13, 2007) or the WDF Quebec Open (January 2008), as an alternative.
