FEES & RATES SCHEDULE

POLICY OBJECTIVES

The primary objective of this policy is to provide a summary of all fees charged and rates paid by Darts Alberta, in accordance with any other policies in effect.

DARTS ALBERTA FEES SCHEDULE

Darts Alberta shall collect fees in accordance with the following Fee Schedule:

1. Membership Fees

- 1.1. Individual Adult or Youth – Darts Alberta / NDFC - \$40.00 per person
- 1.2. Adult League – Darts Alberta only - \$3.00 per league member
- 1.3. Adult League – Darts Alberta / NDFC - \$23.00 per league member
- 1.4. Adult NDFC Membership Upgrade for Adult League Members - \$20.00 per person
- 1.5. Youth Club Members – Darts Alberta only - \$3.00 per youth club member
- 1.6. Youth Club Coaches – Darts Alberta only – no charge
- 1.7. Youth Club Coaches – NDFC Membership Upgrade - 1 free coach per youth club. Additional coaches would be required to pay the upgrade fee.

2. Adult Elite Provincial Championship Program

- 2.1. Zone or District Qualifier Entry Fee - \$30.00 per person¹
- 2.2. Provincial Championship Entry Fee (if Invitational or Zone Qualified) - \$80.00¹
- 2.3. Provincial Championship - Independent Buy-In Entry Fee - \$300.00¹

3. Youth Provincial Championship Program

- 3.1. Provincial Championship Entry Fee (if Darts Alberta Youth Club Member) - \$30.00¹ (includes NDFC Membership Upgrade)
- 3.2. Provincial Championship - Independent Buy-In Entry Fee - \$60.00¹, plus membership fee

4. Member League Provincial Championship Program

- 4.1. League Provincials Entry Fee - \$40.00 per doubles team

5. Adult Provincial Ranked Tournament Program

- 5.1. Ranked Tournament Annual Fee - \$1,500.00 per tournament
- 5.2. Discounted Annual Fee (for Member Leagues of 100+ or Grandfathered) - \$200.00 per tournament
- 5.3. Ranked Tournament Singles Fee - \$1.00 per person, for all ranked singles events

¹ Zone and Provincial Fees are per person based on that overall competition, regardless of the number of days they compete.

6. Team Alberta Player Commitment Fees

- 6.1. Adult Team Member Commitment Fee in non-casino year: \$300.00 per person (can earn \$100.00 back)²
- 6.2. Adult Team Member Commitment Fee in casino year: \$400.00 per person (can earn \$200.00 back)²
- 6.3. Youth Team Member Commitment Fee in non-casino year: \$150.00 per person (can earn \$50.00 back)²
- 6.4. Youth Team Member Commitment Fee in casino year: \$200.00 per person (can earn \$100.00 back)²

7. Darts Alberta Annual General Meeting Tournament

- 7.1. Entry Fee (Members only) - \$15.00 per person for the Adult Singles and \$10.00 per person for the Youth Singles

8. Darts Alberta Pro Am Tournament

- 8.1. Entry Fee (by Invitation only) - \$10.00 per person

9. Darts Alberta (Level 1) Officiating eLearning Course Fees

- 9.1. Course Fee (Darts Alberta members) - \$30.00
- 9.2. Course Fee (non-members) - \$60.00

DARTS ALBERTA REIMBURSEMENT RATE SCHEDULE

Darts Alberta shall reimburse expenses to Board Members, Adjudicators, Coaches and Facilitators in accordance with the following Rate Schedule, when traveling to attend authorized meetings, adjudicating approved competitions or other approved travel in the course of Darts Alberta business:

10. Travel and Accommodation

- 10.1. Auto Expenses: A mileage allowance will be paid, per kilometre, per vehicle, at the rate equivalent to 10 cents less than the current Business km rate in accordance with the Government of Alberta Public Service Subsistence, Travel and Moving Expenses Regulation at the time the travel occurred. Reimbursement will not be provided to anyone traveling in another person's vehicle.
- 10.2. Other Travel Expenses: Reimbursement will be provided when an actual "fee for service" receipt is provided (e.g. parking, shuttle service or taxis) if deemed necessary
- 10.3. Hotel Accommodations: In the case of multi-day events, accommodation expenses will be reimbursed when traveling to attend authorized meetings, adjudicating approved competitions or other approved travel in the course of Darts Alberta business.

11. Daily Per Diem

- 11.1. When traveling to attend authorized meetings, adjudicating approved competitions or other approved travel in the course of Darts Alberta business, Board Members and Coaches will be provided with a prorated per diem based on the following rates when meals are not otherwise provided:
 - 11.1.1. Breakfast - \$10.00
 - 11.1.2. Lunch - \$10.00
 - 11.1.3. Dinner - \$20.00
- 11.2. With the exception of flying on a "red eye" flight, a per diem of \$20.00 will be provided for a travel day when no other business is scheduled for that day
- 11.3. If financial feasible, Youth Team Alberta Members will be provided a per diem of \$20.00 per day for each day of the actual Youth National Championship

² Team members will earn the stated reimbursement if they volunteer at the next Darts Alberta casino or provide a parent or volunteer to work on their behalf

12. Internet Subsidy

- 12.1. Board Members will be provided with an annual subsidy of \$120.00, payable June 30th each year to offset the cost of internet provider services. A prorated amount will be provided to any Board Member not serving a full year.

13. Honoraria Rates

- 13.1. Certified Learning Facilitator Honorarium - \$75.00 per full day when conducting classroom workshops, provided the facilitator meets the minimum accreditation requirements in accordance with the Position Description of a Darts Alberta Facilitator
- 13.2. Certified Adjudicator Honorarium - \$75.00 per full day when adjudicating tournaments on behalf of Darts Alberta provided the adjudicator meets them minimum accreditation requirements in accordance with the Position Description of a Darts Alberta Adjudicator
- 13.3. Disciplinary and Appeals Hearing Panel Member Honorarium - \$75.00 per full day when required to attend and adjudicate a Hearing
- 13.4. Casino Coordinator - \$75.00 per day honorarium for the two days of the Darts Alberta-hosted casino

14. Casino Volunteer Reimbursement

- 14.1. In accordance with Policy 024, the following rates shall apply for Casino Volunteers:
 - 14.1.1. The meal allowance voucher shall be up to a maximum of \$15.00 per volunteer, per shift worked.
 - 14.1.2. Provided the volunteer resides at least 100 km from the casino facility, a gas subsidy shall be paid at a rate of 15¢ per km, per vehicle
 - 14.1.3. Provided the volunteer resides at least 100 km from the casino facility, one night's shared accommodations shall be provided by Darts Alberta, per shift worked
