



# DARTS ALBERTA POLICY

## TEAM ALBERTA FUNDRAISING ADVERTISING

### POLICY OBJECTIVES

The purpose of this policy is to outline expectations regarding the advertising of fundraisers for Team Alberta Members. More team members are being proactive in organizing fundraisers and Darts Alberta has no objection to this happening, provided team members are honest in their advertising.

Darts Alberta contributes well over \$20,000 annually for team members to participate at the Adult Nationals and anywhere from \$12,000 to \$15,000 annually for team members to participate at the Youth Nationals.

As these fundraising activities are increasing, it has been noticed that many posters state that the funds raised will help the team member(s) to go to the Nationals. This is not the case, since everything relative to the National Championships is fully funded by Darts Alberta, except for food and beverages for the Adult Team and any extra activities planned. It is the Team Member's choice to participate in the pre-tournament, the Canadian Open and any other optional events. If the intent of the fundraiser is to help offset costs associated with those extracurricular costs, that is what needs to be advertised.

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Any member of Team Alberta may host a fundraiser to offset the costs associated with food and beverages and any costs associated with other extracurricular activities, provided it is advertised as such.

Team Members are not permitted to advertise or allow advertising by a third party that the fundraising is for "them to go to the Nationals Championships" or any other wording that would be misleading.

Advertising must clearly state that the fundraising is to offset expenses to participate in optional events and/or extracurricular activities.

Team Members are required to initial this section of the Player Agreement to confirm they acknowledge this policy and will comply with it.

Any person found to advertise a fundraising event in contravention of this policy will be subject to Disciplinary Action.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION OF TEAM ALBERTA FUNDING

Provided funds are available, the following funds are provided by Darts Alberta for Adult and Youth Team Members:

Team Commitment Fee	To receive the above funding, Team Members must pay Darts Alberta a \$200 non-refundable fee each year as well as \$100 (in non-casino years) or \$200 (in casino years) which is held in trust and refunded if they volunteer for the casino	To receive the above funding, Team Members must pay Darts Alberta a \$100 non-refundable fee each year as well as \$50 (in non-casino years) or \$100 (in casino years) which is held in trust and refunded if they or a parent volunteers for the casino
